

THE 20 STEPS OF THE TORAH PURSUANT METHOD

A Yeshua-centered path from Scripture to Spirit-led obedience

Begin with Yeshua. Trace the teaching to Torah. Follow it through Scripture and history. Practice it with humility.

1. LISTENING TO YESHUA

1



Begin with a Teaching of Yeshua
Start with the Master's words

2



State the Research Question
Ask a clear and honest question

3



Identify the Torah Root
Find the first strong Torah expression

4



Classify the Command Carefully
Know what kind of command it is

2. TRACING THE TEACHING THROUGH SCRIPTURE

5



Trace the Teaching Through Torah
Follow the theme in the five books

6



Follow the Teaching Through the Prophets and Writings
Hear it preached, prayed, and lived

7



Return to Yeshua with Deeper Context
Read His teaching again with sharper eyes

8



Trace the Teaching Through Acts and the Apostolic Writings
See how the early disciples practiced it

9



Study Second Temple Jewish Context
Hear the teaching in Yeshua's Jewish world

3. LISTENING TO THE WITNESS OF HISTORY

10



Study Early Jewish and Rabbinic Reception
Listen to Jewish memory and reflection

11



Study Early Christian Reception
Learn how early believers received it

12



Study Medieval Interpretation
Notice enduring insights and blind spots

13



Study Reformation and Modern Interpretation
Examine later interpretive habits

14



Study Messianic Jewish Theology and Jewish-Gentile Ecclesiology
Honor Jewish calling and Gentile discipleship

4. TESTING, PRACTICING, AND TEACHING

15



Test Every Interpretation by an Authority Ladder
Separate text, inference, tradition, and preference

16



Add Pastoral Risk Review
Ask how this teaching could be mishandled

17



Seek the Holy Spirit's Illumination and Guidance
Pray for wisdom and obedience

18



Practice the Command in a Measurable Way
Turn study into a concrete act

19



Confirm the Practice in Community
Test the fruit with mature believers

20



Review the Fruit and Teach with Humility
Teach what produces love, wisdom, and mercy
