Parashat Beha'alotcha

June 6, 2026



Torah Reading: Numbers 8:1–12:16

TORAH PORTION

Beha'alotcha moves from the lamps of the menorah and the service of the Levites to the cloud that led Israel, the sharing of leadership with seventy elders, and the failures of complaint and pride. This portion teaches us to walk by God's leading and not by restless desire.

THIS WEEK'S THEME

Follow the Lord's guidance when He leads, and do not carry the work alone. God guides His people, and He also gives help for the journey.

YESHUA AND THE WEEK'S THEME

THEMATIC CONNECTION

Yeshua said, "My sheep hear My voice... and they follow Me" (John 10:27). He also sent His disciples to share the work of the kingdom (Luke 10:1–2). This week calls us to follow His voice with humility and to welcome help instead of carrying every burden by ourselves.

APOSTOLIC WITNESS

'As many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God' (Rom 8:14). "The things that you have heard from me... commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also' (2 Tim 2:2).

PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK

Start each morning with one simple prayer: 'Lord, what obedience is before me today?' Then name one burden you should share with a faithful helper instead of carrying it alone.

QUESTION FOR REFLECTION

Where is God asking me to follow more closely, and what burden should I stop carrying alone?
